



Ensuring Data Compliance with the MRC v3 Tag Checker Beta


Please note: organisations can choose to opt out of the tag checker beta. Their users will not have access to the Validation tab.

The new tag checker beta system is accessed via the Validation tab on the grey title bar shown in contract view.

Validation runs automatically at some contract stages, such as new draft, first bindable quote, and first firm order.



Unfulfilled mandatory requirements are shown on a red field and list the exact issue to be rectified.

This output will be steadily revised and improved as we move through beta.

Defined Data tags in the contract are compared against MRC v3 requirements.



Conditional and contextually-mandatory requirements that may be unfulfilled are shown on a yellow field. By their nature, it is not possible for the checker to verify them precisely.

This output is also being steadily revised and improved.


You can proceed through the placing process as usual regardless of the validation status of the contract. The tag checker is strictly for your reference.

The verification process allows users to make certain that the Defined Data tagging in their contracts is able to support the future generation of a complete CDR message from the Platform.

In addition to the stages where the tag checker runs automatically, you can choose to run a validation at any time by clicking 'Run MRCv3 Validation' on the validation pane.

Summaries of validation results are recorded in the contract's history timeline, accessed via the contract overview page.
