Headline

A signed contract with a pending endorsement that has been reverted to the firm order stage can be shown to other underwriters.

A verticalised contract that has been shown to a facility panel member may subsequently have vertical terms assigned to any underwriter.

Having trailing zeroes on a signed line percentage no longer prevents underwriters from updating references.

Details

- Reverting a signed contract to a firm order when a pending endorsement to the contract was outstanding was preventing new written lines from being applied, including off-platform lines.
 - The error preventing new lines from being put down has been resolved. However, please note that newly-added underwriters are not added to the pending endorsement.
 - To include them, either:
 - show the existing endorsement with the original underwriters and then clone the endorsement, mark the previous version's underwriters as 'Does Not Apply', and show it to the new underwriter/s, or
 - delete the pending endorsement and re-create it once the new underwriter/s are added.
- When preparing a verticalised contract, assigning a vertical term to at least one member of a facility panel and then showing the contract including that term prevented subsequent vertical terms from being assigned to open market underwriters. This error persisted even if the contract was withdrawn from the facility member/s.
 - This issue has been corrected. Vertical terms may be assigned and shown to underwriters in any order as usual.
- When a line was signed with a trailing zero on its value – such as 25.00 or 12.50 – then the line's underwriter would be prevented from updating their stamp reference/s.
 - The error has been corrected, and underwriters can properly update references for lines signed with a trailing zero.
