Headlines

Signed facility agreements which have been shown declarations that went through the Bindable Quotes process can now accept Mid-Term Participant Change endorsements.

Once a declaration made to a shared facility panel was fully written, the facility participation breakdown table was not being shown above the written lines in most instances. This has been corrected.

Resolved Issues

- Mid-Term Participant Change endorsement processing for facility agreements were failing to complete if that facility panel had been shown a declaration which had progressed through the Bindable Quotes stage. This was because the MTPC process was incorrectly registering these declarations as still uncompleted, because Bindable Quotes that are not taken up are still considered potentially active in that contract's history.
 - Bindable Quote data has now been excluded from MTPC error-checking, and facility agreements accept Mid-Term Participant Changes as intended.
- When lines are written on a declaration contract shown to a facility panel, participation of the panel's members is tracked in a table displayed above the declaration's written lines. Following an update to this table, it was no longer being shown for declarations to shared facilities in PDF previews or PDF/Word exports once all participants had written their lines. This was affecting both brokers and underwriters.
 - This issue has been corrected, and the participation breakdown table is now properly being included in preview and export documents.
- Similarly, once all participants had written their lines on a declaration shown to a shared facility, brokers were not able to see the participation breakdown table when looking at the declaration in the Whitespace Platform. Underwriters still had visibility of the table.
 - This has also been corrected, and all users can see the participation breakdown table in the platform as expected.
